# Target group and prerequisites

Secondary school students, grammar school students, employed persons, pupils and students from abroad.

Students must reach the age of majority (18 years) in the same year as the second partial exam. Students must also demonstrate motivation and perseverance as well as confident mastery of languages and scientific and mathematical subjects.

To ensure that this is the appropriate path for each student, we assess the level of all applicants.

Basic competences required include resilience and perseverance as well as sound linguistic proficiency in German, English and an additional national language (French or Italian), and basic skills in maths.
